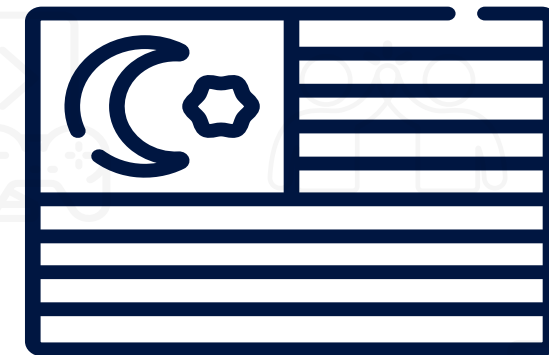
The acquisition of KDU Education

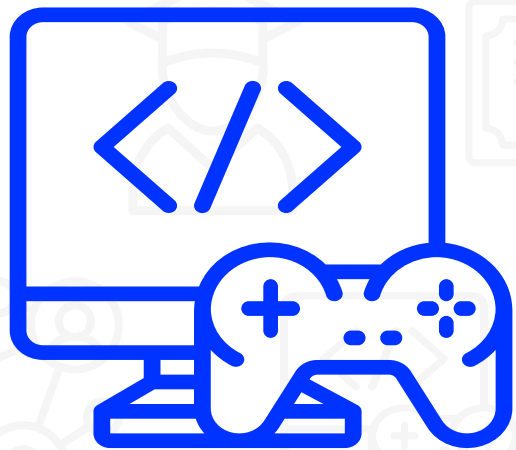

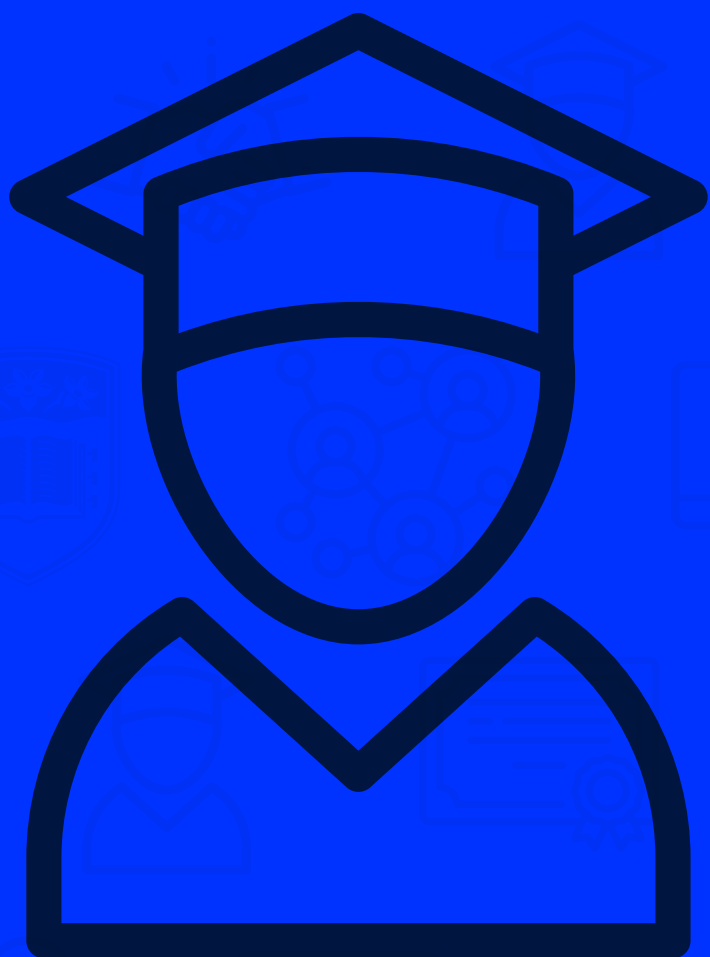
UOW Malaysia is also one of the first culinary schools in the country with **state-of-the-art culinary facilities.**

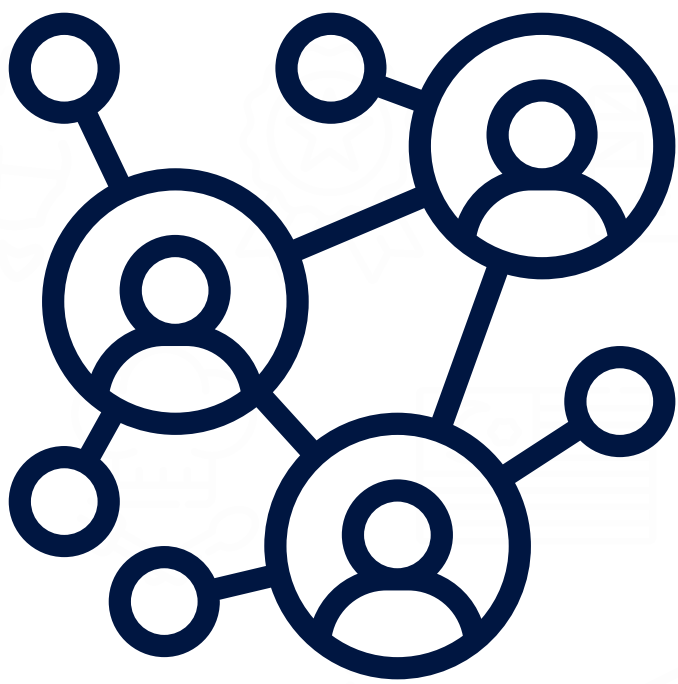
