Malaysian Students

1. UOW Malaysia policy over Subjects Registration.

- You are required to enrol for the subjects within 7 days after the commencement date of the program.
- Enrolment after the stipulated date is subject to the approval from the Head of Academic Department.

2. Attendance & Results.

You are to maintain the following regulations mandated by the Ministry of Higher Education, Malaysia (MOHE):

- To maintain full-time studies status by registering NOT less than 3 subjects per semester.
- To attend all lectures, tutorials, practical and other classes required by the program.
- To maintain 80% of class attendance for each subject per semester. Failing which, you will be barred from the final examination of the program.
- To maintain a minimum CGPA of 2.0 per semester.

International Students

1. **Students Visa Application.** Your acceptance to UOW Malaysia is subject to the approval of your student pass application by EMGS & the Immigration Department of Malaysia. UOW Malaysia will not be held responsible for the time taken to process your application and/or the rejection of your application by the relevant authorities.
2. **Validity of Passport & Pass.** You must hold a valid passport and student pass for the entire duration of your stay in Malaysia. You are responsible for the validity of any kind of immigration pass/ and must abide by the rules and regulations imposed by UOW Malaysia and the Immigration Department of Malaysia.

3. **Report to UOW Malaysia.** You are to report to the International Office (IO), UOW Malaysia within 3 days of your arrival, to pay all outstanding fees, to proceed for medical examination and submit your passport for endorsement of student pass.
4. **Payment of Fee.** You are required to report to the Admission & Bursary Office to pay the program fees and to present the original certificate(s) and supporting documents within 7 days after the commencement date of the program (please refer to UOW Malaysia's Bursary Policy).
5. **Payment of Insurance, Medical Examination, Student Pass & Personal Bond.** You shall bear all charges related to your insurance/ medical examination/ student pass/ personal bond or penalty charges by EMGS & the Immigration Department of Malaysia.
6. **No Employment.** You are not allowed to engage in any kind of work or occupation in Malaysia while holding a student pass unless you have obtained written approval from the Immigration Department of Malaysia.
7. **Extension of Student Pass.** All application for extension of student pass must be submitted to the International Office 2 months before the expiry date of your student pass.
8. **Withdrawal.** You must inform UOW Malaysia in writing if you wish to withdraw from the institution and report to the International Office for cancellation of your student pass. UOW Malaysia reserves the right to forfeit the caution fee, to make a police report and inform the Immigration Department of Malaysia to cancel your student pass, if you fail to do a proper cancellation before leaving the country.
9. **Inactive.** If you have registered but failed to attend any classes 1 month after the commencement date without informing UOW Malaysia officially, you will be classified as having withdrawn. All fees and security deposit will be forfeited and UOW Malaysia will inform the Immigration Department of Malaysia to cancel your student pass.
10. **Refund of Fee.** Refund of fees is subject to UOW Malaysia's Bursary Policy.
11. **Deferment.** You must obtain the written approval from your Head of Department if you wish to defer your studies (please refer to UOW Malaysia's Bursary Policy). You have to return to home country during the deferment period.
12. **Code of Conduct.** You are required to abide by the UOW Malaysia Code of Conduct and Code of Discipline.

All fees must be paid in full on or before commencement of each semester. There is a grace period of 7 working days (including Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays) from the commencement of each semester for fees to be paid. A late payment penalty charge of RM10 per day will be imposed on all outstanding fees after the grace period. If fees are unpaid after the fifth week of a semester, students are not allowed to register for the current semester and will be deferred to the next semester.

All fees received in advance are deemed to be for payment of course fees.

Students who have outstanding fees will not be allowed to proceed on to the following semester of studies and may be terminated from their studies.

International Students pursuing **Certificate in Intensive English (CIENG)** are required to **pay 2 Level of course fees upfront. The fees paid are NOT refundable.**

REFUND OF FEES

Registration and Admission Fees are non-refundable.

Students requesting a refund must fill up a Request for Refund form which is available at Admissions & Bursary Department.

If student withdraws from the University/College within fourteen (14) days from the date of commencement of a semester, 50% of the tuition fees will be refunded. No refunds are allowed if student withdraws after fourteen (14) days from the date of commencement.

Caution Fee is refundable upon completion of the program. In the event of a withdrawal/termination of studies, only 50% of the Caution Fee will be refunded. Caution fee will be offset against any outstanding fee prior to refund.

Request for refund is only processed: if a student withdraws or has completed his or her studies.

International students are required submit student pass for cancellation before the refund can be processed (applicable for withdrawal and completion studies). Students are required to surrender their student card upon withdrawal / completion of studies. A penalty of RM20 will be deducted from the student's account if they fail to return the card.

The University/College will take a minimum of 30 working days to process the refund upon receipt of the Request of Refund form from the student. Student will be notified to collect the monies when the refund is ready.

In all circumstances, students are advised to collect refunds/ monies within 6 months from the date of completion of studies or 6 months from the date as stated in the letter of collection of refund, failing which, the said monies shall be forfeited by the University/College.

DEFERMENT OF STUDIES

Students are allowed to defer their studies for ONE (1) semester ONLY. Students have to write to their Academic Department Head for approval of the deferment.

Student who has withdrawn/deferred/left the programme for more than one year is liable to pay again the Admission (for international student), and Registration fee upon re-admission.

Note: The University/College reserves the right to change the Bursary Policies when deem necessary.
